- **Web-site solution**

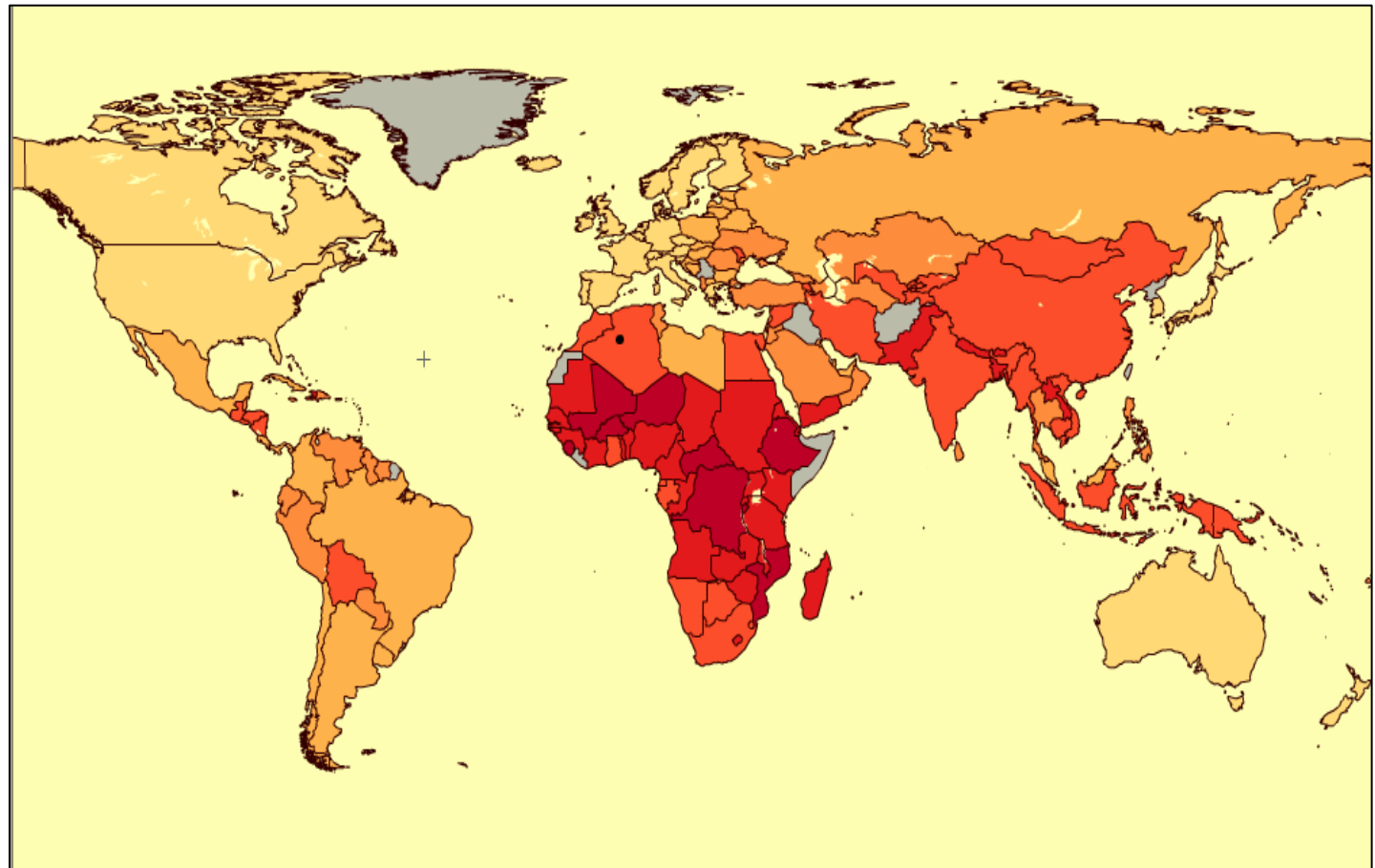
How Would CHEMTREC Do This?

 - Other resources (such as the 2004 ERG)


Where Would We Find The Info?
