
What is REGTREC?

REGTREC is a valuable research and compliance tool that allows our customers to get a high-level overview of the chemical regulatory environment in up to 29 different countries. It contains country-specific regulatory information about the governing laws, the government agencies that create them, and in some instances, the guidance needed to comply with them.


How to Access REGTREC

1. REGTREC can be accessed from our public website by logging into the CHEMTREC customer portal using your username and password.


*TIP: If you don't have your credentials, you can use the "Need Help?" radio buttons just below the login to recover them



2. Once logged into the customer portal, click on the REGTREC tab located at the top of the page.



3. You should now see the REGTREC landing page. Click on the "View REGTREC Information" button located at the bottom of the page to go to the REGTREC tool (this may require scrolling down).






How to Navigate REGTREC

1. Upon gaining access to the REGTREC tool, you will be able to navigate between countries by clicking on the down arrow in the top left corner, beside the country name.

*NOTE: USA + Canada and Multi-country customers will see the United States and Canada in this dropdown list, whereas Worldwide customers will have access to all 29 available countries.



2. There are eight (8) sections within each country view. These can be browsed through the top navigation menus, or by clicking on the section icons.

*TIP: You can hover over the section icons to get a brief overview of the content contained within.

*NOTE: If a country has not yet implemented laws pertaining to a section, it will be denoted by a "no entry" symbol underneath of the section icon (as shown here for Substance Registration).
